Fujitec Delivers the Fastest Elevators in Sri Lanka at the Lotus Tower, the Tallest Structure in South Asia

Hikone city, Japan, Oct. 8, 2019 – Fujitec Co., Ltd. (President: Takakazu Uchiyama) announces that Fujitec Lanka (Pvt) Ltd., a Sri Lanka-based group company of Fujitec, has delivered 14 elevators and escalators for the Lotus Tower, a broadcasting tower that is the tallest structure in South Asia. Three of the elevators are high-speed types that travel at 420 meters per minute, making them the fastest elevators in Sri Lanka.



The Lotus Tower

The 356-meter tower in Colombo, Sri Lanka's largest city is shaped like a lotus, the national flower of Sri Lanka. In addition to serving as a broadcasting tower that transmits signals for 20 television stations and 50 radio stations, there is an observation deck that stands at a height of 250 meters, in the lotus bud portion of the tower.

Fujitec Lanka delivered six elevators, including the three high-speed types that travel at 420 meters per second, along with eight escalators equipped with vivid blue lighting under the handrails.

Construction commenced in 2012 and was completed on September 15, 2019. The tower has become a notable landmark of Sri Lanka.
