

Fujitec Delivers 33 Elevators and Escalators in New 54-Story Landmark in Taipei, Taiwan

Elevators that save space in common areas of buildings with custom office specifications

Fujitec Co., Ltd. delivered 33 elevators and escalators in the Headquarters Building of Fubon Financial Holdings through its Taiwanese Group Company Fujitec Taiwan Co., Ltd. (President: Charles Chen). The 54-story office building was constructed as headquarters to Fubon Financial Holdings, a major Taiwanese financial group.

The elevators installed pair double-deck elevators, featuring two vertically-connected cars, with the EZSHUTTLE control system, which assigns an elevator car to passengers automatically for shorter riding times. Both types of elevators have custom-made specifications for large office buildings, and this installation marks the second case of integrated installment by the Fujitec Group.

Double-deck elevators hold twice the capacity of elevators with the same car size. When combined with EZSHUTTLE, user riding times are reduced by up to an additional 55%*. Combining these products enables Fujitec to improve operation efficiency without increasing the number of units installed, saving space in common areas of building typically used for elevators. In this way, Fujitec helps alleviate elevator traffic congestion supports during rush hours, and supports comfortable travel for officer workers.



Main Specifications

1. Double-Deck Elevators

A double-deck elevator is an elevator that features two vertically-connected cars. These elevators carry two cars of users at the same time, allowing for simultaneous use on two separate floors. Passengers choose elevators according to their destination floor. (i.e., using the elevator from the first floor to reach odd-numebered floors, and using elevators from the second floor to reach even-numbered floors.) These specifications are suitable for large, high-rise buildings with high traffic.




2. EZSHUTTLE

EZSHUTTLE is a system in which passengers register their destination floor before boarding the elevator, allocating the optimal elevator in use to the user and streamlining operations without increasing the number of elevators. This system is designed for large office buildings that are prone to long waits during morning commutes and other times of the day.



Ride on the assigned elevator by checking the Destination Floor Indicator on the car entrance column*.



Depending on the specifications of elevators, there may be Destination Floor Indicators at the elevator entrance floors.

Card keys are scanned at the security gate



Floors visited for work are pre-registered on the card



Gates assign the optimal elevator immediately



Users can register floors in the elevator hall when going to other than those previously registered



Elevators are button-less, as destination floors are automatically registered
