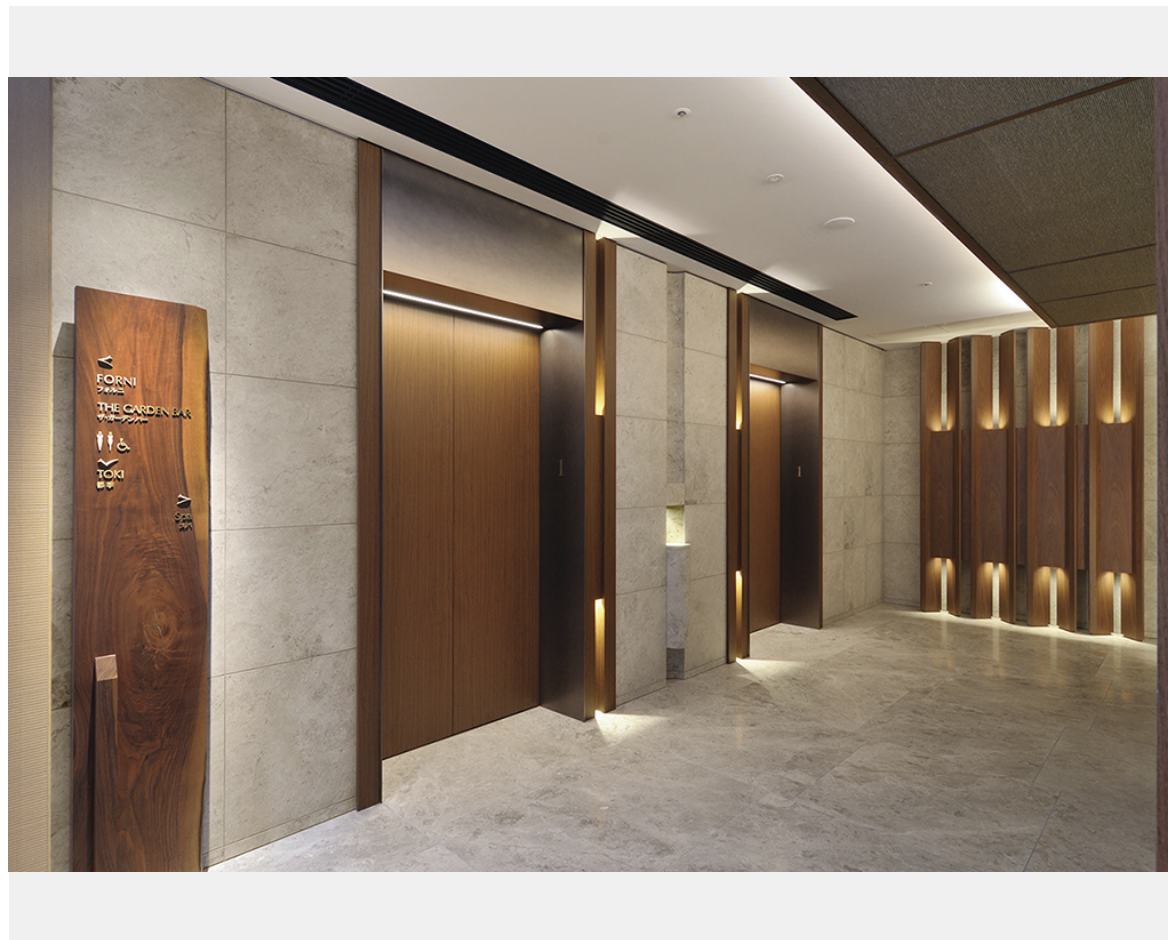
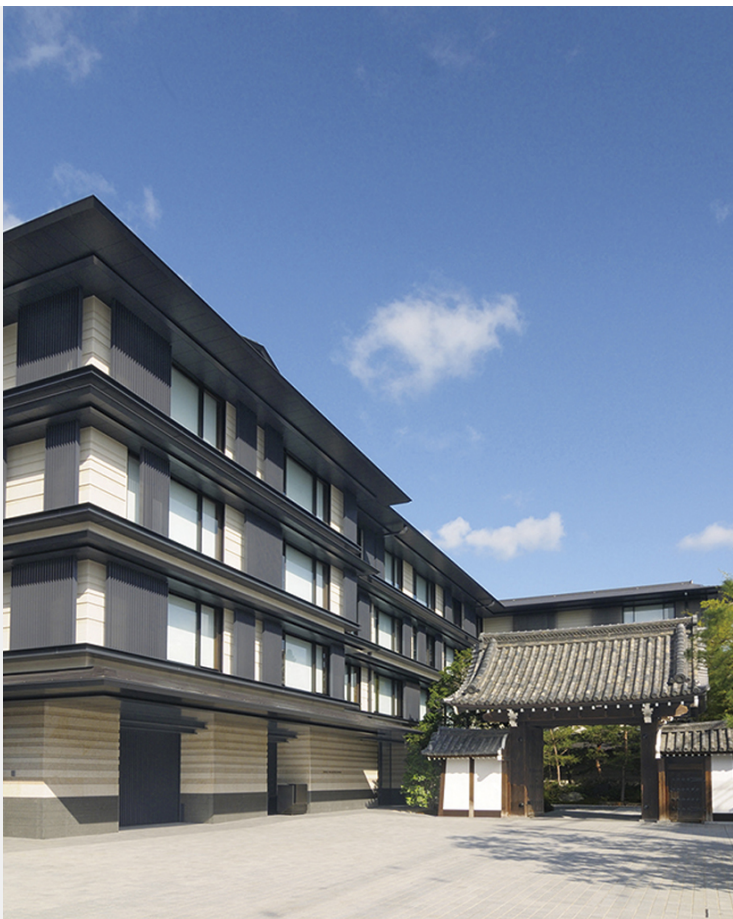
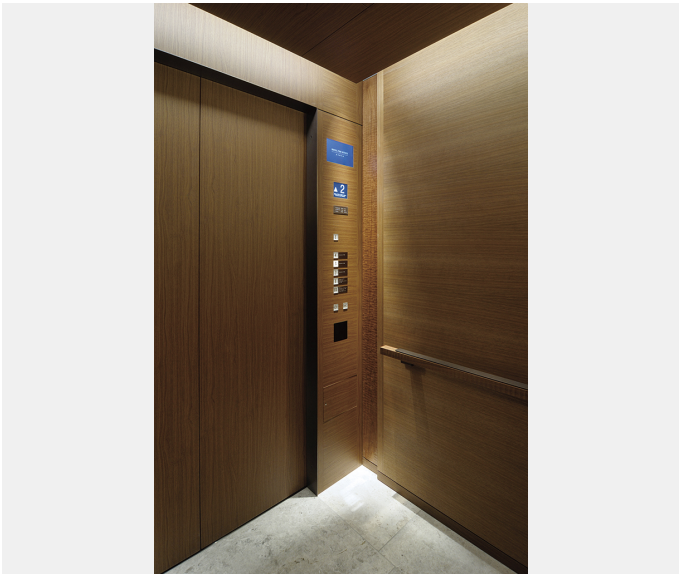
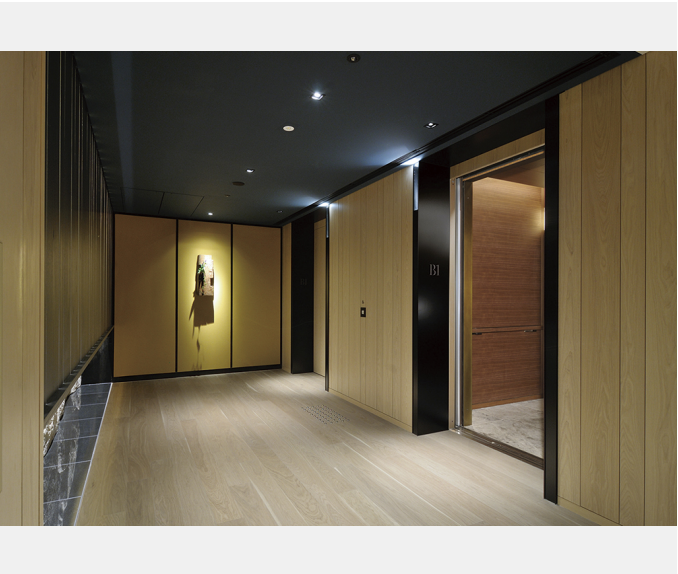
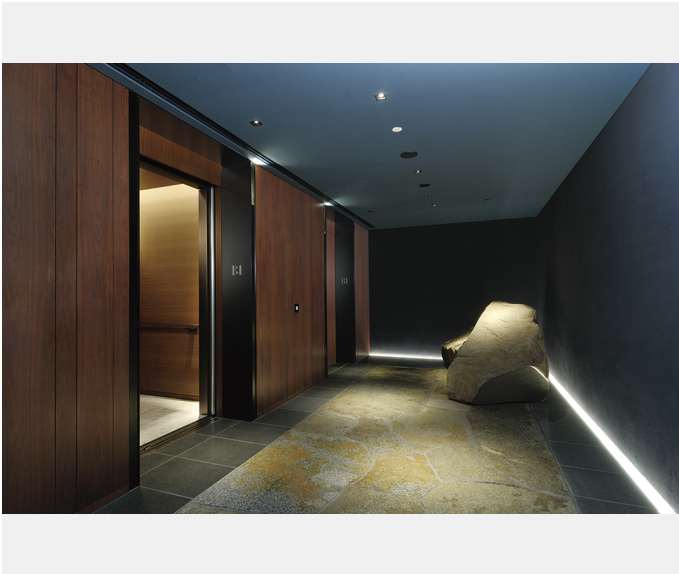


Nijojo Castle was established by the Tokugawa Shogunate as a monument protecting the Kyoto Imperial Palace. HOTEL THE MITSUI KYOTO is only minutes away from the castle.
