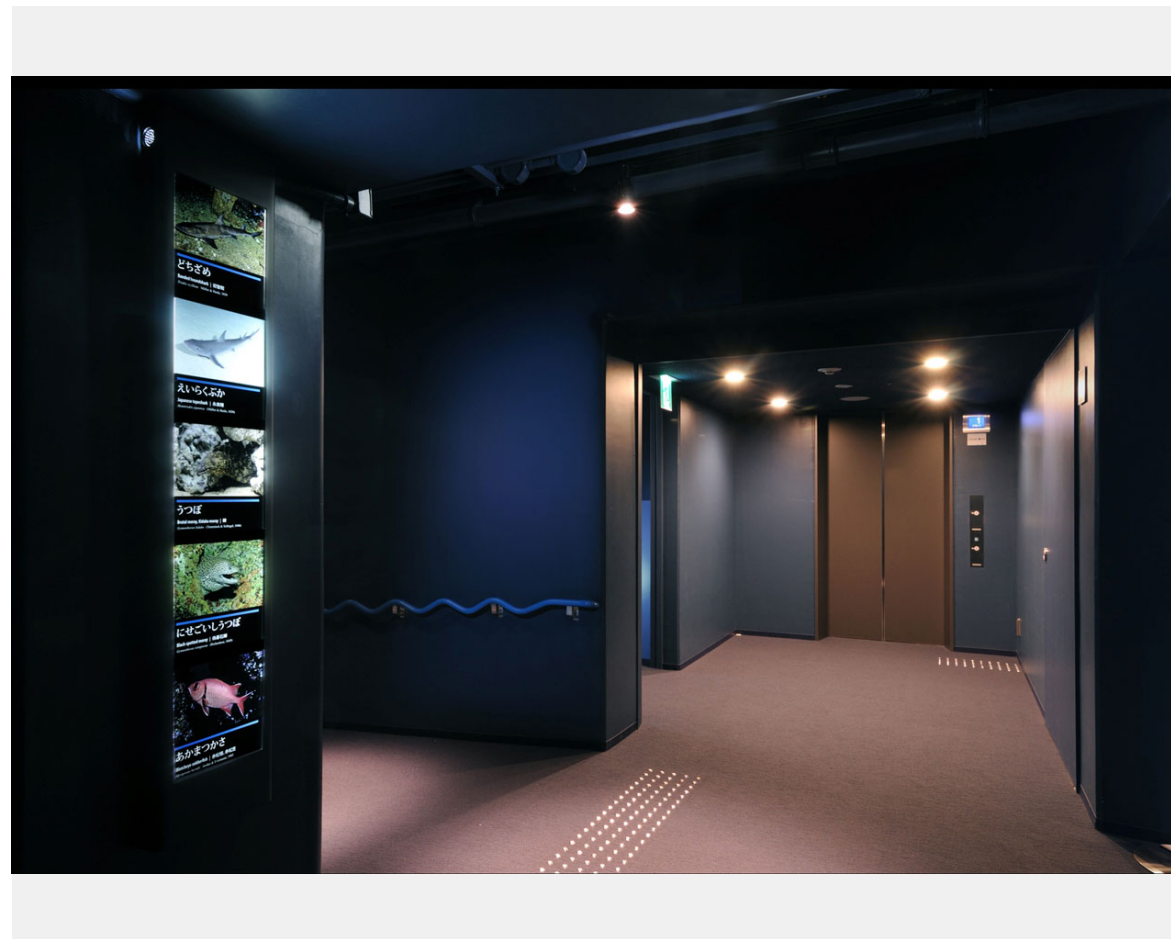


Located in Umekoji Park, Shimogyo-ku, Kyoto City, the Kyoto Aquarium is Japan's first full-scale inland aquarium. The three-story facility with a total floor area of approximately 11,000 m<sup>2</sup> shows some 15,000 marine and freshwater creatures including approximately 250 marine species such as Japanese giant salamanders, seals and penguins. The elevators installed beside Dolphin Stadium, directly facing the five-story stupa of Toji Temple, are protected against brine damage caused by sea water.
