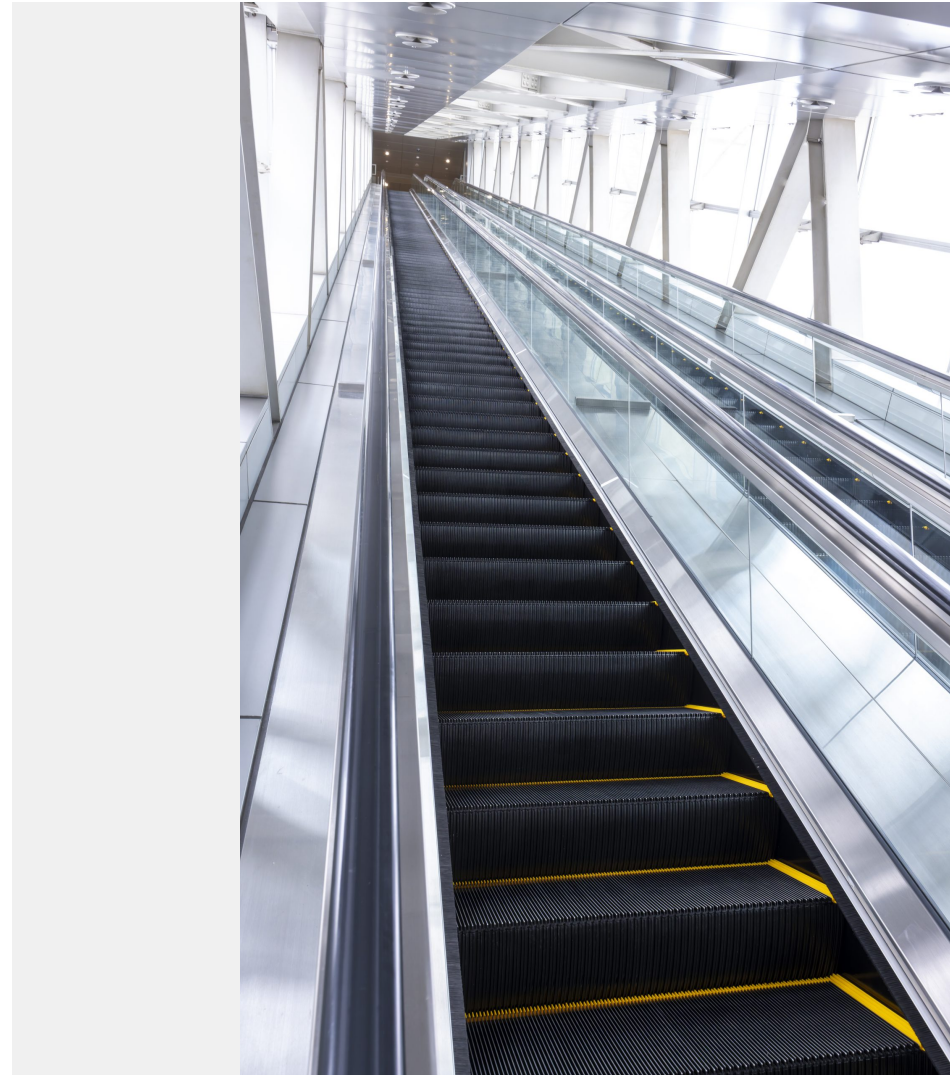
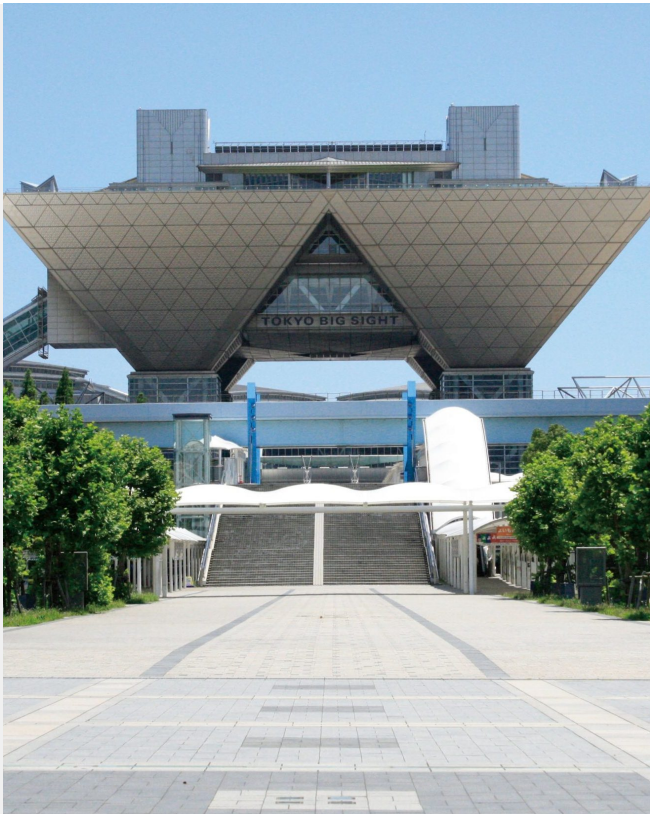


Tokyo Big Sight is Japan's largest international exhibition center with a total floor area of 316,990 square meters. As a leading exhibition business stage in Japan, Tokyo Big Sight provides "encounter" and "excitement" to visitors.

As the Fujitec escalators had been in operation since the original completion of Tokyo Big Sight in 1995, they have been upgraded to improve their safety level and functionality.

It is noteworthy that two (2) of the twelve (12) operating escalators are the longest escalators Fujitec has ever installed in Japan. Their total length is 45 meters; their height is 22 meters.

The upgraded escalators are newly equipped with "Dress Guards." The brushes of these Dress Guards, which are installed on the right and left sides of the escalator steps, prevent shoes and clothes from getting caught and contribute to the safety of users.
