Having the headquarters at Okaya City in Nagano Prefecture, Nihon Pisco Co., Ltd. is a maker that specializes in the development, manufacturing, distribution, and sales of pneumatic equipment. The three (3) - floor main plant that has been newly constructed at the headquarters' premises plays a key role as a new core hub.

Fujitec has installed one (1) observation elevator at this premises. The observation elevator is installed inside a spiral staircase. The observation elevator with the decorating fixtures that adopt many glass-made transparent plates is harmonized with the surrounding space and gives the whole facility space an open feeling.

As a more remarkable feature, Fujitec's AirTap buttons are used on the elevator landing floors and inside the elevator. The AirTap buttons that have been developed in Fujitec's consideration for the aspect of good hygiene realize the comfortable movement of people and bring Safety and Reassurance to them.
